Hi, Boris, Ed -

Attached is a proposed release of Lisa Heinzerling's schedule, in response to a FOIA request from Landmark. The schedule has a number of WH and EOP-related items on. From my review, these appear to be designated under one or more of the following: White House, WH, OMB, CEQ, and/or Jackson Place.

Two questions:
