## **ORDER**

At Wilmington, this 17th day of April, 2014, for the reasons set forth in the Memorandum Opinion issued this date, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- (1) Defendants' Motion to Dismiss For Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction and Failure to State a Claim (D.I. 19) is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**.
- (2) Plaintiff John A. Nichols' ("Nichols") dormant Commerce Clause challenge

  (Count I) is dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1) for
  lack of standing; Nichols' challenge under the Equal Protection Clause of the

  Fourteenth Amendment (Count II) is dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil

Procedure 12(b)(6) for failure to state a claim. Only Plaintiff FuelCell Energy, Inc.'s dormant Commerce Clause challenge (Count I) remains.
