VISA FRAUD

University of Nebraska at Omaha [An example of a quick response by the FBI and referral to an agency that was best suited to detain a student feared to be potentially violent.]

The University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) had a student who the university believed posed a threat to the safety of the campus. On 8/17/2010, the student received a notification of allegations of misconduct from the UNO Judicial Officer. The student was alleged to have violated the UNO Student Code of Conduct by lying on her application to attend UNO. The letter also stated that the student was not to attend classes for the duration of the investigation and was to contact UNO's Judicial Officer to obtain permission before coming onto UNO campus.

On 8/19/2010, the student arrived at the College of Business Administration and was engaged in a verbal confrontation with staff. She did this in violation of the aforementioned letter and without the permission of the Judicial Officer.

On 8/20/2010, the student was present at an administrative hearing. Subsequent to the hearing the student was issued a Ban and Bar letter and expelled from the university. Following the issuance of that letter, the student continued to harass the staff at UNO. Additionally, the student filed a complaint with the Omaha Police Department alleging blackmail and intimidation on the part of the UNO staff. The police found no evidence to support the student's claim.

During the course of UNO's investigation into the student's alleged violations, UNO staff discovered blog posts by the student displaying empathy and sympathy for Seung Hui Cho, the Virginia Tech shooter. The student's actions as well as her posts led to the staff of UNO being fearful of the student. UNO's Clinical Psychology Training Program staff has been unable to develop a profile of the student. A preliminary assessment conducted by the CPTP staff indicated the student developed a grudge against UNO employees which had "the potential to manifest itself in violent action."

Once expelled from UNO, The student was no longer in compliance with the requirements of her visa and was "out of status."

On 9/28/2010, FBI Omaha was contacted by UNO. On 9/29/2010, the FBI requested all pertinent documentation relating to the student. On 9/30/2010, copies of the pertinent information were provided to the FBI. The information was then forwarded to Department of Homeland Security and Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

On 10/1/2010, the student was arrested by ICE for being out of compliance with regards to her visa. The student is being held by ICE pending her deportation hearing.

This issue was resolved quickly through the established relationships between the FBI and the university.

Tri-Valley University: Pleasanton, California

Dozens of officials from the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) raided the offices of Tri-Valley University, and the home Tri-Valley University president, Susan Su in January 2011. It appears the university served as a front for illegal immigration operations.

ICE officials noticed enrollment nearly tripled in a matter of months to over 1,500 students- almost all from the same region of India, and each paying \$5,400 per semester to the schools founder, Susan Su.

Court documents say "since its inception, Tri-Valley University has been a "sham" university which Su, and others, have used to facilitate foreign nationals in illegally acquiring student immigration status that authorizes them to remain in the United States." Su was caught giving F-1 student visas to undercover agents posing as foreign nationals, who told her they wanted to come to the U.S, but had no intention of attending classes.

No criminal charges have been made yet.

C. Frank Figliuzzi
Acting Assistant Director
Counterintelligence Division

A Connecticut native, Mr. Figliuzzi earned a Juris Doctorate with honors from the University of Connecticut School of Law, and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in English Literature from Fairfield University. He is a graduate of the Harvard University, John F. Kennedy School of Government, program for Senior Executives in National and International Security.

Mr. Figliuzzi was appointed an FBI Special Agent in August 1987 and assigned to the FBI's Atlanta Division where he worked terrorism and foreign counterintelligence investigations. In 1992 he was promoted to the National Security Division at FBI Headquarters in Washington, DC, with responsibility for oversight of economic espionage matters.

In 1995, Mr. Figliuzzi was named Supervisory Senior Resident Agent, Palo Alto Resident Agency, in the FBI's San Francisco Division. His office, near Silicon Valley, California led the FBI in investigations of foreign sponsored thefts of trade secrets. In 1997, Mr. Figliuzzi was tasked to lead one of the FBI's first squads exclusively devoted to crimes against children. This San Francisco squad was responsible for responding to child kidnapping, investigating child pornography, and unsolved child abductions and murders. In 1998, Mr. Figliuzzi was promoted to Unit Chief in the Office of Professional Responsibility at FBI Headquarters. In this position he adjudicated allegations of serious misconduct against FBI personnel in the Eastern United States.

In 1999, Mr. Figliuzzi was appointed Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the FBI's Miami Division, the fifth largest in the country. He led the Miami Division's White Collar Crime Branch known for its successful investigations of high profile public corruption and corporate fraud cases. Following the attacks of 09/11/2001, Mr. Figliuzzi was selected to head FBI Miami's new Counterterrorism Branch. He implemented the South Florida Joint Terrorism Task Force with 160 personnel from 34 agencies. He served as on-scene commander during the nation's first anthrax murder in Boca Raton, Florida.

In August 2004, Mr. Figliuzzi was promoted to Inspector. Based in Washington, DC, he led teams responsible for assessing FBI operations around the world. In December 2005, Mr. Figliuzzi became the FBI's Chief Inspector. FBI Director Robert S. Mueller, III, named Mr. Figliuzzi the Special Agent in Charge of the Cleveland Division on October 4, 2006. He reported as Deputy Assistant Director, Counterintelligence Division, on November 7, 2010.

Mr. Chabinsky serves as Deputy Assistant Director within the FBI's Cyber Division. The Cyber Division manages all FBI domestic and international investigative and outreach efforts focused on protecting the United States from cyber attack, cyber espionage, online child exploitation, Internet fraud, intellectual property rights theft, and other high technology crimes. Mr. Chabinsky recently returned to the FBI after completing a joint duty assignment with the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI), where he served as Assistant Deputy Director of National Intelligence for Cyber (Acting), the Chair of the National Cyber Study Group, and the Director of the Joint Interagency Cyber Task Force. In these roles, Mr. Chabinsky led the ODNI's efforts to coordinate, monitor, and provide recommendations to the President regarding implementation of U.S. cyber strategy. Prior to his ODNI tour, Mr. Chabinsky served as Chief of the FBI's Cyber Intelligence Section, where he organized and led the FBI's analysis and reporting on terrorism, foreign intelligence, and criminal matters having a cyber threat nexus.
