I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated September 23, 2010, in which you ask me "to investigate a very serious allegation that Administration employees may have improperly accessed and disclosed confidential taxpayer information." Your letter cites section 6103 of the Internal Revenue Code, the provision of the United States Code which protects the privacy of Federal tax returns and their information.

Thank you for bringing this matter to my attention. As the Inspector General charged with ensuring, among other things, the fair implementation of our Nation's system of tax administration, pursuant to Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration practice, I have ordered the commencement of a review into the matters alleged.

As you are aware, there are certain constraints on my ability to share information from our review with you in the absence of a request from the Chairman of the Committee on Finance.
