Vermont. [NOTE: For approximately three years, the Cuban study abroad program at UW-Madison has been suspended; however, SIT Study Abroad anticipates securing a license to reinstate Cuban study abroad programs in January of 2012].

(U) After exchanging pleasantries and business cards, the writer provided [redacted] an overview of the FBI's Strategic Partnership Initiative-Academic Alliance. The writer clarified the purpose and mission of the FBI's Strategic Partnership Initiative, explained the threat, discussed matters relative to espionage, and proposed the possibility of FBI Milwaukee providing security briefings to prospective students planning to study abroad in Cuba. The writer added the Cuban study abroad program would be an excellent opportunity for UW-Madison students to promote diplomacy and good-will between the U.S. and Cuba;
