Dear Mr. Gavoor:

This is in response to the March 3, 2015, voicemail you left on the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Public Affairs telephone seeking the status of a complaint and request for investigation you submitted to OIG.

Your request as to the disposition of your complaint poses a question, which is outside the scope of the Freedom of Information Act, through which individuals may request records. However, we conducted a search for records relative to your request and were informed there was an open and ongoing investigation concerning this matter. Should OIG require additional information we will contact you directly.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2006 & Supp. IV (2010)). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.
